SECTIONS

Lending Section: It is the biggest section of the library in terms of the number of books and diversity of collection. the lending section hosts text books that are issued to the patrons. it has collection on diverse subjects ranging from traditional subjects like English literature to recent modern subjects like food technology. The books are arranged neatly subject wise and in numbered shelves for easy accessibility.

Reference Section: The section comprises of books that can be used for references purposes only. the section has many rare and antique books manuscripts maps etc. the section is adequately equipped with updated collection to answer the reference queries of the patrons and provide them enough extended information. Encyclopedias, dictionaries, directories, etc. are available here.

Reading Room: The library has a well-lit spacious reading room where patrons can read latest as well as back issues of newspapers, journals, magazines etc. This section makes regularly available local, national dailies, weeklies and monthlies.

Reprographic Section: This section provides reprography facilities to students at nominal charges. Patrons can have Photostat / print copies of reading material, previous years question papers etc.

Career Corner: This section has collection of career oriented books to help patrons to crack various competitive examinations. The section has updated books on various entrance like nursing, PMT, NEET, JEE as well as civil service examinations like Upsc, JKPSC etc.

Browsing Centre's: The library has two browsing centers each for boys and girls, equipped with around 35 All in one desktops with high speed internet and power backup facilities.

Power backup: This section has modern power backup facilities to ensure round the clock operation of the library. Online heavy UPS, inverter and power generators are its main equipment.

Server room: The room houses the servers of the library management software.



Instructions:

The library is open round the year in official breaks except on Public Holidays.

Each student is allowed to draw one/two books from the library.

Students should show their identity cards to the library in-charge for the purpose of identification at the time of using any library facility and borrowing books.

Any book reported to be lost by the borrower should be replaced by a new one.

Books will be issued to the students for a period of one semester.

Few back numbers of magazines, project reports are available for issue.

Books should be returned on the due dates. Belated returns will be accepted only on payment of fine calculated as per the rules in force.

Book donations are always welcome.

Books will be issued for staff as well.
